RHP 9 Roadshow: Texas A & M University Baylor College of Dentistry

Background: Texas A & M University Baylor College of Dentistry (BCD) began providing faculty, four dental students and two dental assistants at North Dallas Shared Ministries in June 2013. Initial service volume was 18 patients per day.

Currently: BCD is providing faculty, six dental students, and three dental assistants. Patient volume is currently 30 patients per day. The majority of patients are uninsured adults with chronic diseases such as hypertension and/or diabetes. Services include: cleanings, deep scaling, extractions, fillings, root canals, and flippers.

Future plans: pediatrics will be added in December 2015. A multi-disciplinary team is being created to integrate dental, medical, social services, and behavioral health services into a patient-centered, patient-valued health home. Collaborative practice across disciplines, mechanisms to improve care coordination, and system level initiatives to improve the quality of care provided will be included in the coming year.
