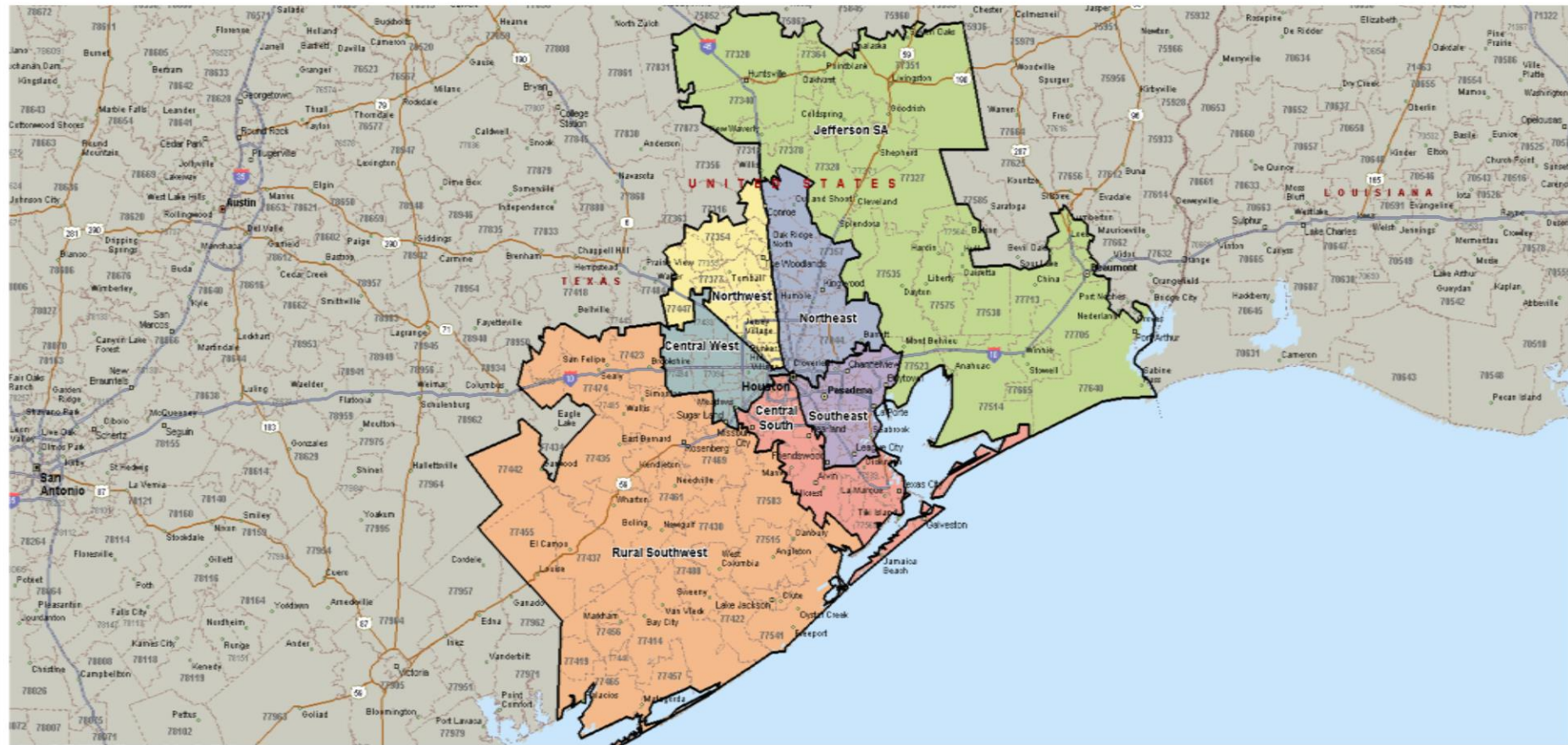

- Adults and Children with disabilities (waiver/SSI)



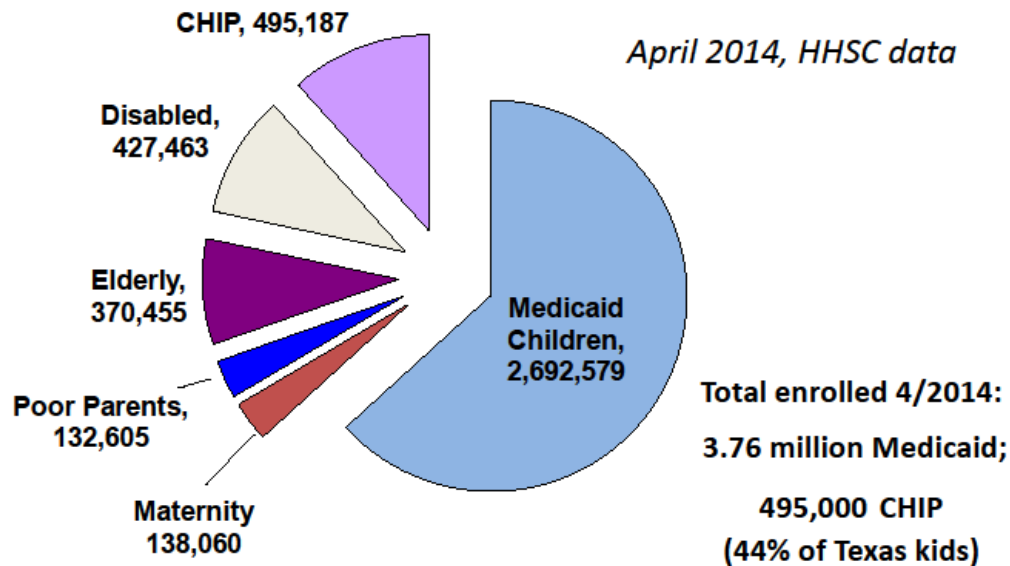
