ARAD Program Description

- Licensed Intensive Outpatient Treatment for addiction to drugs/alcohol for homeless adults residing in a local homeless shelter.
- 16 clients at a time.

ARAD Program Description

- Program 5 and 1/2 days a week.
- 9 to 4.
- Provide lunch 6 days a week.
- Provide transportation from and to shelters.
- Provide transportation to AA or NA meeting 4 nights a week.

ARAD Partnerships

- Seven homeless shelters.
- Texas Panhandle Centers.
- Family Support Services.
- ROSC.

ARAD Original Funding

- Mary E. Bivins Foundation.
- United Way of Amarillo & Canyon.
- The Brumley Foundation.
- Downtown Women's Center.

ARAD Outcomes

- Data from February 2013 through December 2015.
- 358 clients.
- 66% graduation rate – 228 clients.
- Male graduation rate – 45%; female 55%.
- Highest graduation rate for African Americans; Males 40 to 49.

ARAD Outcomes

- Contact with graduates 60 days after completion.
- 68.4% contact rate.
- Track sobriety.
- Track arrests and hospitalizations one year pre-treatment and post-treatment.

ARAD Outcomes

ARAD Outcomes

<u>Outcome</u>	<u>Pre-Treatment</u>	<u>Post-treatment</u>	<u>Change</u>	
Arrests (all clients)	370	68	302	-81% \$1,510,000
Arrests (graduates)	215	27	188	-87% \$940,000
Arrests (contact)	148	17	131	-88% \$655,000

Arrest valued at \$5,000

Hospital (contact)	89	78	13	-12.4% \$165,000

Hospitalization valued at \$15,000
